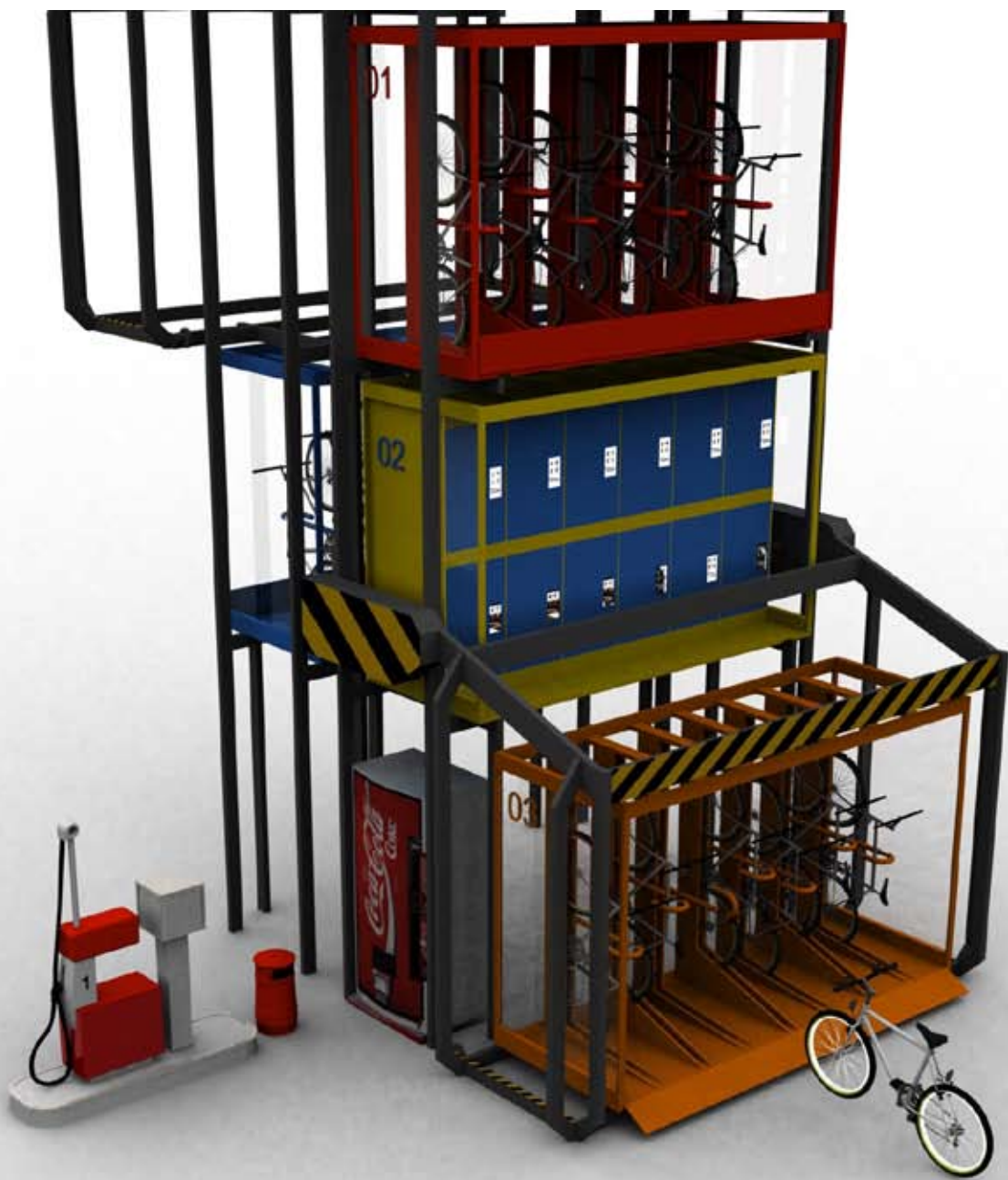
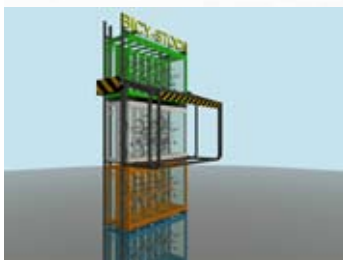
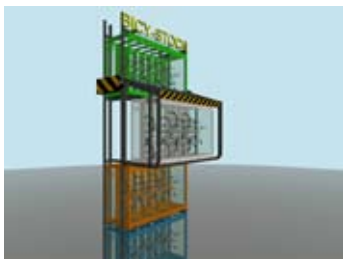
DESIGN WORKS

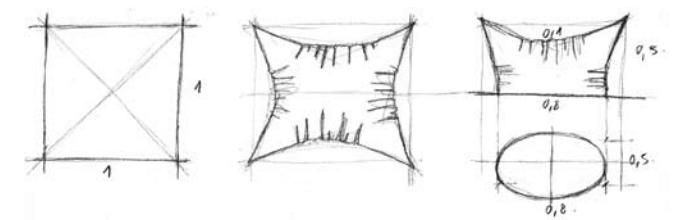
Workshop in France with the University of Applied Arts of Helsinki, the Camondo and Duperré schools from Paris :

The theme of this workshop was «love in winter». The students were invited to design and produce a space or a furniture only with wood and fabric. In two weeks, my team has realised a kind of suspended sofa called «the nest». It was really comfortable and aesthetic with a weaving made of fabric and cotton. We have made two structure, one evolutive but fragile, and one fixed but stronger.





This is an inflatable structure made of PVC and rubber band. The goal was to realise a simple and affordable shelter as big as possible.

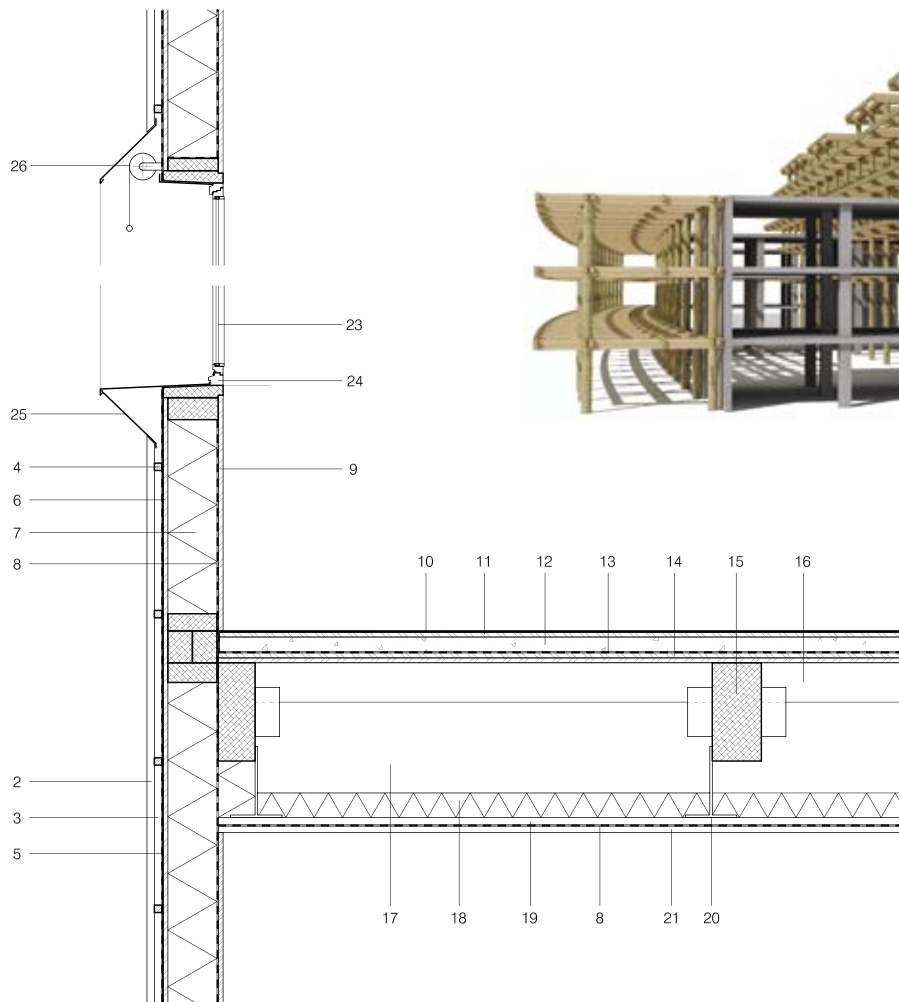
